### Loosen Bros. Dr. L Riesling 2021

**[89] Owen Bargreen**

A killer value, [this wine] shows plenty of minerality once on the mouth. Layers of Pink Lady apple collide with wet stone and shades of kerosene on the palate. *May 22, 2023*

**[88] View from the Cellar**

The wine offers up a lovely nose of pear, apple, violets, slate, and a touch of honeycomb. On the palate the wine is medium-bodied and juicy, with a nice core, good mineral undertow and pretty good length and grip on the well-balanced finish. *September-October 2022*

**[85] Wine Enthusiast — Best Buy —**

This is playing it safe, with just enough orchard fruit and acidity to match. *February 2023*

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### Loosen Bros. Dr. L Sparkling Riesling NV

**[86] View from the Cellar**

The wine offers up a pretty nose of apple, tangerine, a nice base of minerality and white flowers. On the palate the wine is bright, zesty, and full-bodied, with a good core, slightly coarse mousse and good length and grip on the well-balanced finish. *September-October 2022*

**[85] Wine Enthusiast — Best Buy —**

Direct flavors of peach and lemon mark this vibrant white. *February 2023*

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### Loosen Bros. Dr. L Riesling Dry 2019

**[89] Owen Bargreen**

Juicy and delicious, the Trocken-inspired dry Riesling offers sourdough bread and Gravenstein apple flavors alongside plenty of stony minerals. *May 22, 2023*

**[87] View from the Cellar**

The bouquet wafts from the glass in a mix of apple, tart orange, a lovely base of slate, white lilies, and a touch of bee pollen in the upper register. On the palate the wine is bright, medium-full, and nicely defined by its minerality, with zesty acids, fine focus and a long, well-balanced and quite dry finish. *September-October 2022*

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
