Villa Wolf Gewürztraminer 2021

[91] Tasting Panel Reviews

A delicate perfume of white flowers, fresh linen, and white grapefruit leads to an exquisite entry laced with peach nectar. Papaya brings in a glossy tropical character, melding with a smattering of gardenia. *January/February 2023*

[89] Owen Bargreen

Delicious and dry, this wine displays ripe peach mango flavors alongside wet stone and shades of white rose water on the palate. *June 2023*

$[\star\star\star\star\star]$ Restaurant Wine

It is round, medium bodied, and very floral and fruity in flavor (litchi nut, honeysuckle, lime, rose petal, white pepper), with good balance, and a very long aftertaste. Remarkable value. 2023, Issues #204 - #209



Villa Wolf Pinot Gris 2021

This offers light pear and peach notes alongside stony undertones. *June 2023*

$[\star\star\star\star]$ Restaurant Wine

Young and distinct in aroma and flavor (pear, pineapple, grapefruit), this wine is supple in texture, nicely balanced, and lingers on the finish. Excellent value. 2023, Issues #204 - #209

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Villa Wolf Pinot Noir Rosé 2021

Ballet-slipper pink with just a tinge of grey, this piercing Pinot Noir Rosé offers concentrated strawberry and raspberry flavors swathed in layers of fresh green herbs. Linear in style and vibrantly balanced in acidity, it's a revitalizing wine with a juicy cassis finish. *January 2024–Reviewed by Anna Lee C. Iijima*

This is pretty straightforward in terms of flavors, but there is some substance in the background. *May 2023*

[87] View from the Cellar

The wine offers up a very generous bouquet of white cherry, melon, a good base of soil tones and a topnote of dried flowers. On the palate the wine is bright, full-bodied, and wide open in personality, with a good core, sound framing acids and sneaky length on the well-balanced finish. *September-October 2022*

[87] Owen Bargreen

Made from Pinot Noir grapes, this shows very light red fruits alongside citrus rind accents on the palate. *June 2023*

Fresh and fragrant in style; with plum, cherry, rose petal, and white peach flavors, good balance, and a crisp finish. Excellent. 2023, Issues $\pm 204 - \pm 209$



Villa Wolf Sparkling Pinot Noir Rosé NV

Seductively tart bites of raspberry and red cherry permeate through this easy-drinking yet elegant, mouthwatering rosé made from 100% Pinot Noir.
