



ZILLIKEN (SAAR/MOSEL)

- Highly acclaimed estate in the cooler-climate Saar valley.
- Renowned for featherlight Rieslings that “float like a butterfly.”
- A family winegrowing tradition since 1742 – emphasis on family.
- Current owner is Dorothee Zilliken, the seventh generation.
- 30 acres of estate vineyards in Saarburg, Ockfen and Ayl.
- Traditional winemaking in 1,000-liter Fuder casks.
- Deepest cellar in the Saar Valley stays perfectly cool and wet.
- Average annual production: 6,000 cases.

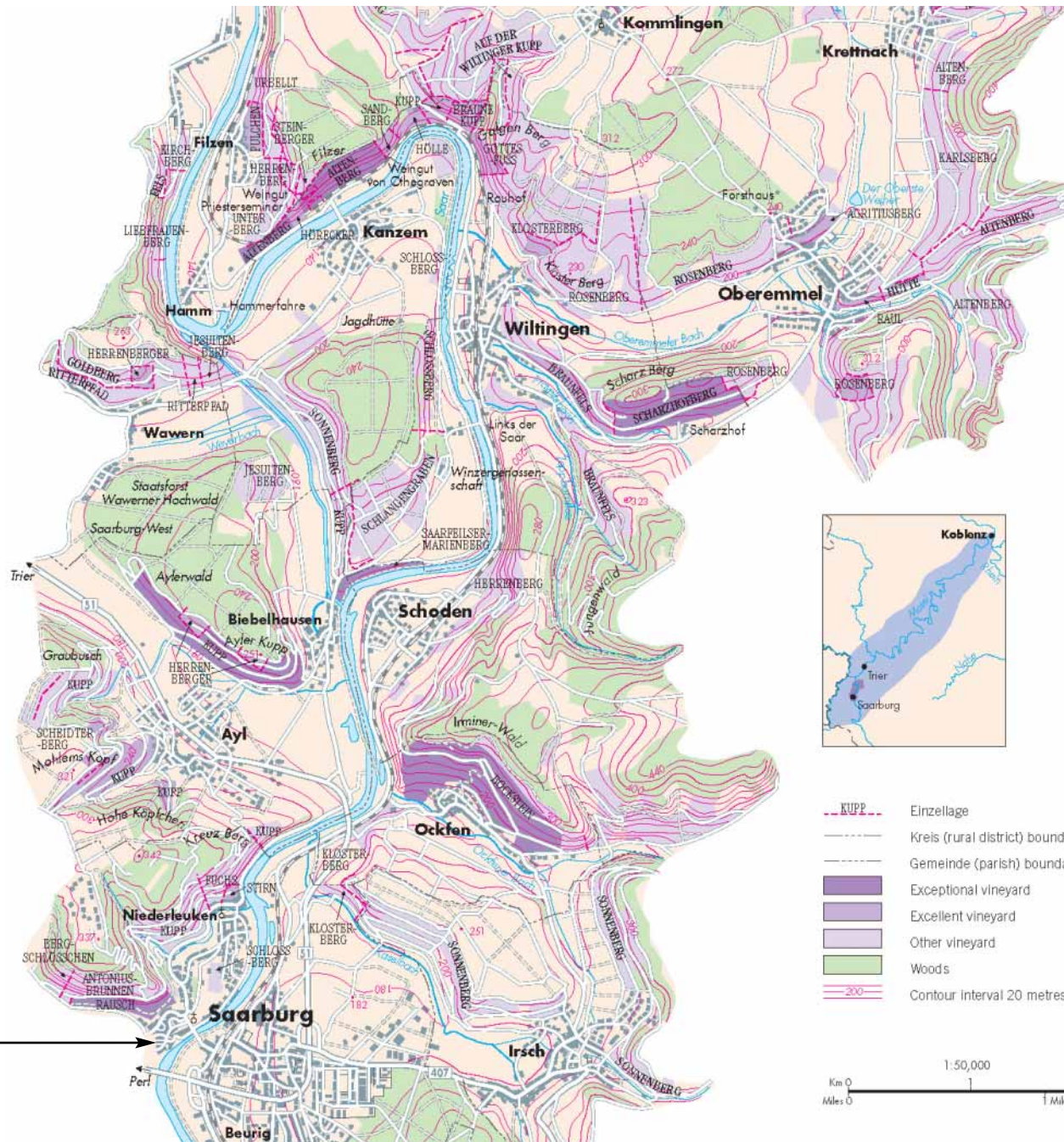
