



VILLA WOLF (PFALZ)

- Historic Rhine valley winery, acquired by Erni Loosen in 1996.
- Located in the Pfalz region of southern Germany, directly north of Alsace.
- Traditionally crafted, fruit-forward varietal wines that are exceptional values.
- Approachable style built for modern dining: crisp acidity, moderate alcohol, clean finish.
- Managed by winemaker Patrick Möllendorf.
- Same dedication to quality and value as the Dr. L wines.
- Sustainably made and vegan friendly.
- Average annual production: 35,000 cases

Key wine descriptors: Fresh, Delicious, Drinkable, Affordable.

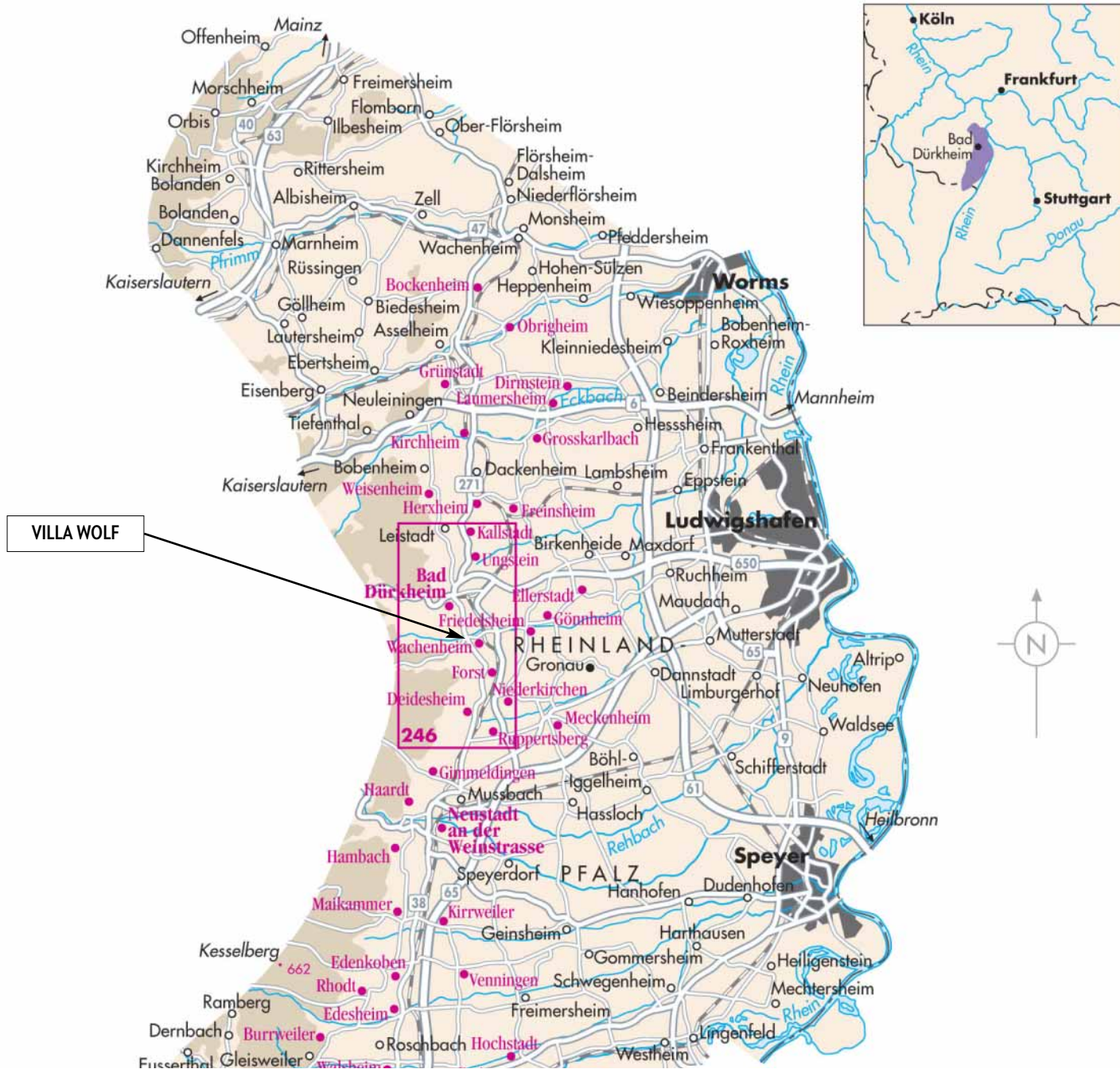

Stony, perfumed wines.

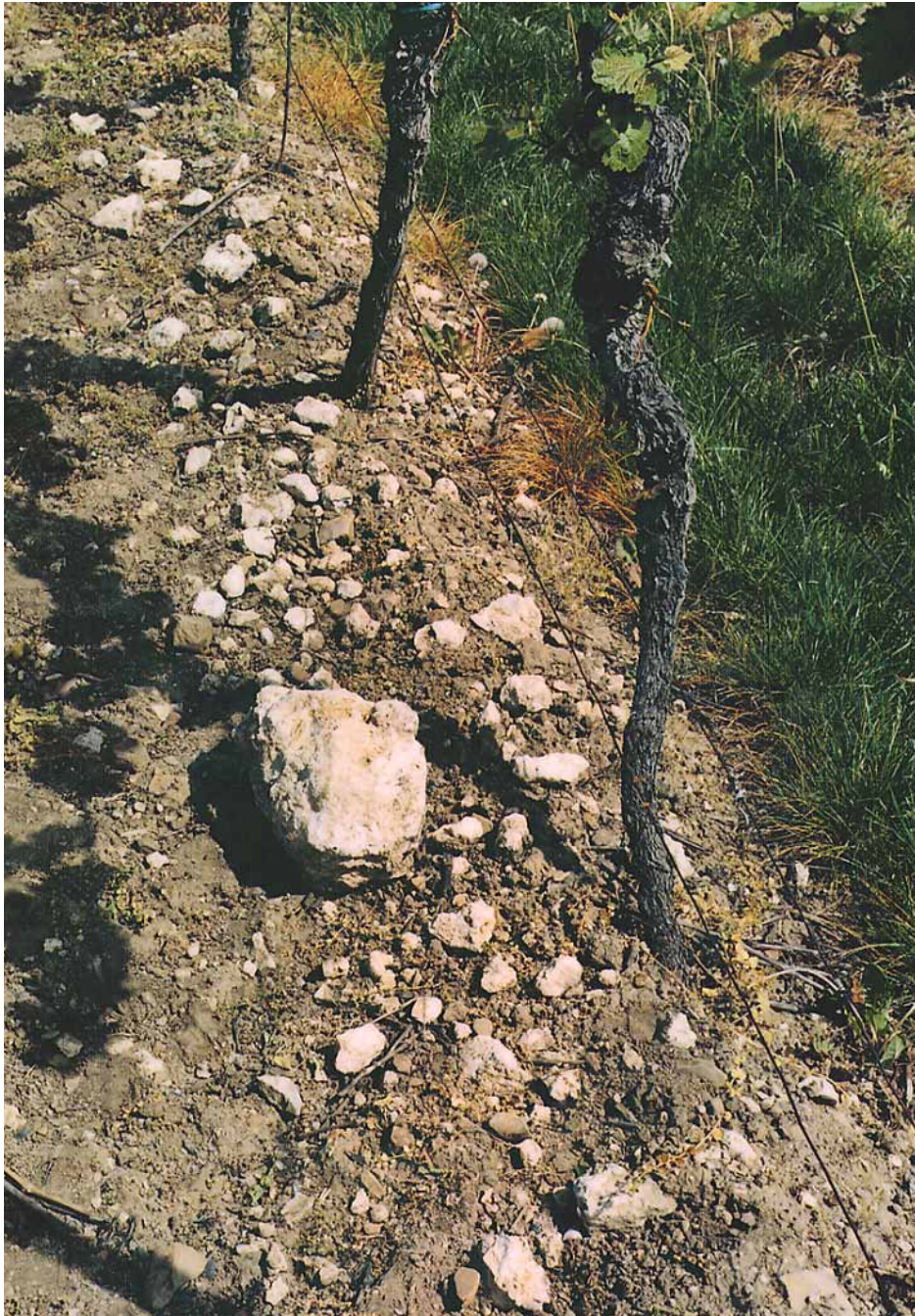
FORSTER PECHSTEIN
