Wine has been flowing in the Clare Valley since 1851 and is an integral part of the culture. A small area, accounting for less than 1.5% of Australia's total wine production, it is one of Australia's most prestigious premium wine regions, most famous for its Riesling and Shiraz.

With its beautiful rolling hills, ideal winter rainfall, and Mediterranean climate, the Clare Valley carries a unique history and winemaking heritage.

The tiny village of Watervale (population of 246), nestled in South Australia's Clare Valley, is renowned for the quality of its Riesling.

Our Watervale Riesling is picked from a special part of the Florita vineyard in Watervale. This famous Riesling vineyard usually achieves full ripeness with high natural acid levels.

Winemaking Notes

In the glass, the 2020 Watervale Riesling is pale straw in colour. The nose has lifted notes of freshly cut citrus and lemon balm with lively bath salt aromas. The palate is fleshy and fruit-weighted with lemon and lime zest flavours.

A slate-like mineral finish balances this mouth-watering, classic, Watervale Riesling.
