

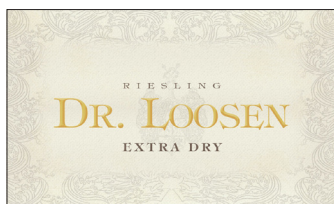

[91] *Wine & Spirits*

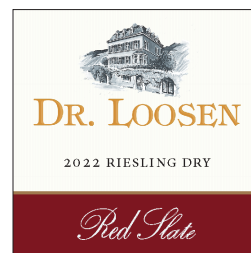
This 100-percent-Riesling cuvée sees nine months on the lees and is bottled with a textured 12 g/l of residual sugar. The wine exudes notes of pears spiced with garam masala that lift across the palate with white flowers. *Reviewed by Jonathan Eichholz, March 2024*

[88] *Wine Spectator*

A tasty-well balanced and refreshing sparkler, with lively mousse buoying delicate apple and peach flavors. A touch of sweetness softens the racy beam of acidity pulsing through, while notes of dried green herbs and wet stone add detail. *June 2024*

[87] *Wine Enthusiast*

Aromatic, showing peach, hazelnut and butter notes in a crisp, light-bodied package. It's more open and fruity, with decent intensity and length. *May 2024*



Dr. Loosen Riesling Dry “Red Slate” 2022

The wine offers up a refined bouquet of apple, gooseberry, salty slate minerality, dried flowers, bee pollen and a touch of petrol in the upper register. On the palate the wine is bright, full-bodied, and mineral-driven, with a good core, a fine girdle of acidity, lovely focus and a long, balanced and complex finish. *Reviewed by Jonathan Eichholz, March 2024*

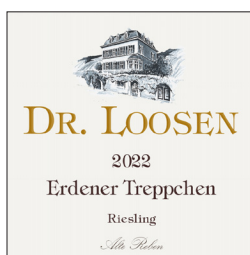
[88] *Wine Spectator* — Savvy Shopper —

Inviting white blossom and peach flavors are powered by mouthwatering acidity in this tasty version. Citrus zest and slate notes mark the palate. *June 2024*

Taut and crisp, with mineral flavors that are infused with notes of dried sage. Interesting mix of honey and lanolin on the moderate finish. *May 2024*

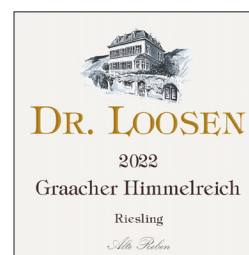
Intensely spicy and flinty nose with stacks of anise and fennel seed character. High tensile strength on the palate although it is only medium-bodied. Great wet stone minerality and herbal intensity at the extremely long focused finish. *September 2023*

[94+] *View from the Cellar*

The wine's bouquet is bright and precise, hopping from the glass in a mix of tart orange, green apple, a complex foundation of slate, wild yeasts, orange peel and a top note of elder flowers. On the palate the wine is vibrant, full-bodied and focused, with a fine core of fruit, lovely slate mineral drive and grip, zesty acids and a long, complex and quite elegant finish. Fine, fine juice. *Reviewed by John Gilman. August 2024*

[91+] *Mosel Fine Wines*

Delicately smoky and herbal, it opens up to offer a beautifully fresh and impressive nose of spearmint, greengage, lime tree, citrus and plenty of spices. The wine proves straight and driven by an acidic backbone on the palate, which gives it quite some austerity and raciness. The finish is pure and taut, with quite some tartness in need of integration. *December 2023 – Issue #68*

A seriously concentrated and structured Mosel GG with stacks of ripe peach and apricot fruit, and behind that is a very exciting minerally acidity that gives this stunning drive at the long, stony finish. It is slightly austere, but the intensity is great and this just needs a bit of time in the bottle. *September 2023*

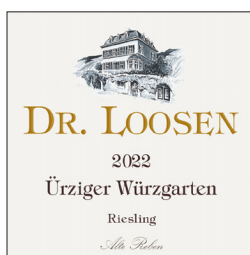
[93] *View from the Cellar*

Offers up a refined bouquet of lemon, green apple, beeswax, a lovely foundation of grey slate minerality, lavender and gently musky white flower tones as a top note. On the palate the wine is vibrant, young and full-bodied, with a sleek, very elegant profile, a fine core of fruit, superb mineral drive and cut and a long, well balanced and nascently complex finish. *Reviewed by John Gilman. [90+] *Mosel Fine Wines*

The first nose is still quite reduced and needs a few minutes before offering notes of yellow peach, orange peel, apricot, acacia, lavender, and thyme. The wine directly shows a tangy touch which runs through the entire palate and gives an energetic tension to the whole, but also a certain austerity. *December 2023 – Issue #68*

Dr. Loosen Ürziger Würzgarten Riesling GG 2022

The wines of this site have a reputation for aromatic extravagance, and this is by no means reserved, but this Würzgarten GG also has fantastic elegance. Glides over the palate, the concentration married to a silky texture and light-footed personality. Stacks of delicate wildflower and herb aromas. *September 2023*

[94] *View from the Cellar*

The wine offers up a bouquet of lime, tart strawberry, citrus blossoms, a complex base of volcanic minerality, a touch of wild yeasts and a top note of lemon zest. On the palate the wine is full-bodied, complex and tightly knit, with a fine core, excellent mineral undertow, bouncy acids and a long, nascently complex and beautifully focused finish.

[92] *Mosel Fine Wines*

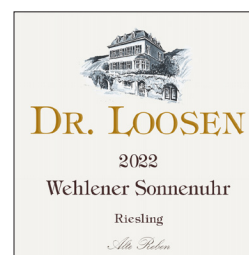
Offers an attractive and even seductive nose with fine fruity notes including yellow peach, tangerine, candied grapefruit, spearmint, jasmine, acacia, and smoke. The wine has a hint of roundness on the palate, supported by the fine fruitiness, but shows excellent precision and focus in the long and very spicy finish. There is even a lot of freshness in the aftertaste, with a very minty side and a touch of tartness which still needs to integrate. This is an impressive GG.

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Chicago Wine Press

This GG dry Riesling displays a pale-yellow hue that shows purity in the glass. It is extremely aromatic, revealing a racy, fruit driven personality with a range of spices, citrus and tropical fruits of lemon zest, orange peel and a hint of salinity. The voluptuous palate is powerful with exotic fruit undertones. The expansive mid-palate maintains a wonderful balance as it caresses your palate for minutes. The finish is lovely with a slight creaminess and a precise finish that goes on and on. There is a whirlwind of tropical flavors in this wine that is mind-blowing, leaving an impression that will last for decades.

This needs a moment's aeration for the fine stone fruit aromas to emerge. Stunning concentration and succulence, but also impeccable balance this is a great Mosel GG that will give so much pleasure in years to come. In spite of everything there is a lovely delicacy at the finish. *September 2023*

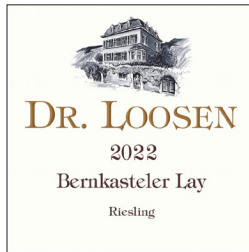
The wine's aromatic constellation is stunning, offering up scents of tart pear, green apple, a touch of white cherry, a gorgeous base of grey slate, just a hint of vanilla bean, lime zest, wild yeasts and a top note of citrus blossoms. On the palate the wine is deep, refined, full-bodied and complex, with a rock-solid core of fruit, great mineral drive and grip, impeccable balance and a long, vibrant and very, very, promising finish. *Reviewed by John Gilman. [92] *Mosel Fine Wines*

Initially impressively smoky and minty, it delivers fresh and aromatic notes of citrusy fruits, acacia, orange blossom, aniseed, freshly cut herbs, greengage, and ginger. The wine has a great presence on the palate, where some juicy white and yellow fruits are wrapped in zesty acidity, lots of spices, and aniseed. The finish is straight, pure, and vibrating. This is an impressive, aromatic, and racy GG.

Brimming with white and yellow peach interwoven with a delicate leesiness and an elegant acidity, this medium-bodied and beautifully proportioned Mosel GG won't need long in the bottle before it really shines. Intensely slatey lemon zest finish. *September 2023*

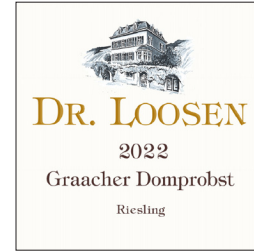

The first nose is immediately appealingly fresh, with a pronounced smoky note, lots of fine and hot spices, thyme, spearmint, lavender, flint, white pepper, and mustard seed. The wine shows great finesse on the palate, with white fruits, mint, and citrus. The finish is very precise, with intensity and length. This is a superb GG, racy, and taut. *December 2023 – Issue #68*

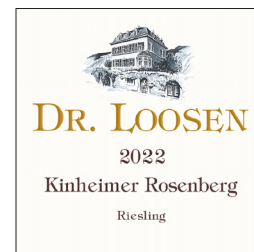

This concentrated and tightly wound GG has a terrific structure, but the leesiness is still quite pronounced, the fruit aromas still a bit closed. Only some cassis showing now. Great focus and drive on the very focused yet only medium-bodied palate. I love the intensity of the wet stone finish. *September 2023*

[91] *Mosel Fine Wines*

The nose is directly rich and even quite aromatic, with notes of yellow peach, spicy pear, cassis, jasmine, and thyme. The wine is rather ample and imposing on the palate, with a touch of roundness and fruitiness, which is very well packaged in a racy, slender, and tense finish. *December 2023 – Issue #68*

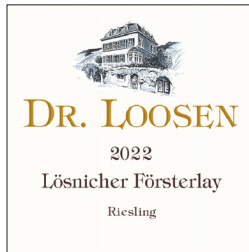

This concentrated and tightly wound GG has a terrific structure, Very attractive nose of orange blossom and persimmon. Good concentration, lively, but beautifully integrated acidity and attractively juicy fruit make this Mosel GG a no-brainer. Long animating finish with stacks of stone fruit character. *September 2023*

At first intense smoke and cassis, then the ripe apricot fruit emerges from behind the leesy aromas and makes a bold statement. A generous, emphatically dry and structured Mosel GG in spite of the moderate acidity. *September 2023*

[90] *Mosel Fine Wines*

It shows quite a floral and elegant nose of anise, earthy spices, mint, rosemary, candied citrusy fruits, and fennel. The wine has good grip and balance (with just a light touch of juicy presence) on the nicely focused and playful palate. The finish offers a mix of citrus and light tartness, still in need of integration. This is a superb, racy GG. *December 2023 – Issue #68*

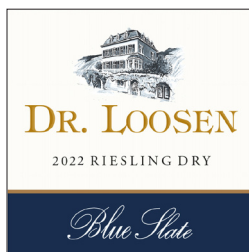

What a juicy and animating light Mosel Kabinett with lime zest and mint character, plus good yellow and green apple fruit. Long, super-clean finish. And the total impression is of a wine that's barely off-dry. *September 2023*

This shows a little bit of lusciousness, but the acidity keeps it honest. Features notes of sweetened chamomile tea, with lemon and quince notes mingling at the core. Minerally accents emerge before the long finish. *May 2024*

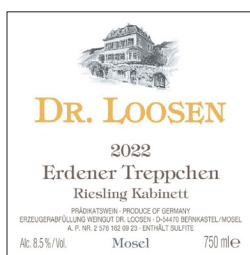

Friendly citrus and light peach flavors are round yet energetic in this off-dry version. Shows great balance and lusciousness on the medium-weight palate, with wet stone minerality and a hint of green herbs keeping the finish fresh. *June 2024*

This is a truly impressive Kabinett that transports you through the spectrum of cherries and apples. After piquing your interest with its alluring nose, on the palate it delivers focus, lift, and flavors tessellating through a long finish. A revolutionary style of Mosel Kabinett! Enormously expressive nose with notes of anise and hibiscus. What an exciting interplay of racy acidity and exotic aromas this barely off-dry Mosel Kabinett has. Stunning tannin structure that gives this a blast of energy and makes it feel much drier than it really is. *September 2023*

This is open knit with notes of nectarine, guava and spice. Lively acidity runs through, keeping the elements in harmony and imparting firmness on the finish. Good length. *May 2024*

Chicago Wine Press

The color is pale yellow which appears effervescent in the glass. The aromas are vivid and expressive with white flowers, ripe nectarine, plum, and spice supported by a mild amount of minerality. This off-dry Mosel Kabinett has wonderful depth, a rich fruit structure and a lovely silky mouthfeel. The palate is energetic and has spirited acidity interwoven into the core that gives it a lift, keeping the wine harmonious while maintaining a firmness on the long fruit-driven finish. It offers a superbly fresh and herbal nose of spices, rosemary, thyme, lavender, smoke, vineyard peach, and conference pear. This is a refreshing, complex, and light weighted Kabinett to enjoy by the bottle.

What an exciting herbal and spicy nose this has! Yes there's plenty of white tree fruit character, but it is pushed into the background. As it aerates, aromas of hibiscus, blood orange and rosemary climb out of the glass. At once juicy and intensely herbal at the crisp finish. *September 2023*

If you were to open the Book of Riesling, this would be page one in the Kabinett chapter. Coming from the famed site with its 19th-century sundial, this wine leads with featherweight tropical citrus, crunchy orchard fruits and scents of lilies. [90] *Wine Spectator* — Savvy Shopper —

Perfumed, vibrant and very tasty, offering fresh floral and lilac flavors around an opulent core of off-dry yellow apple and persimmon. Shows good weight and energy through the medium-bodied finish, which rings with talc-fine mineral notes. *June 2024*

[89] *Wine Enthusiast*

Cooked apple and white-currant flavors are accompanied by hints of pineapple in this friendly version. Finished with delicate spicy notes that are framed by minerality accents. *May 2024*

Chicago Wine Press

This wine reveals a pale-yellow color with a bouquet of gardenia and steely slate in the nose. It glistens in the mouth with a wealth of juicy, citrus glazed fruits in the middle along with mandarin orange and white peach rounding out the finely chiseled edges. This wine has an exotic mouthfeel given the concentration of fresh fruits, but the delicate acidity keeps everything in balance.

The Loosens make a wine here that is both nostalgic and novel. The nose of the wine transports me to my '00s childhood of yellow Sour Patch Kids, then takes me to the present in its scents of thyme, ginger, and fresh flowers, all within a poised and powerful palate. *Reviewed by Jonathan Eichholz, March 2024*

I love the interplay of ripe and slightly caramelized pear fruit with spicy complexity in this ripe yet lively Mosel Spätlese. The vibrant blood orange character easily balances the natural grape sweetness on the ample palate. Long zesty finish that's barely off-dry. *September 2023*

[93] *Mosel Fine Wines*

The first nose brings a superb freshness with fine floral notes (white flowers), fine spices, grapefruit skin, lime zest, flint, lead pencil, smoke, anise, and thyme. The wine initially shows a juicy, fruity side, with a creamy touch lining the palate, amplified by a lower acidity sensation. The finish is still very fresh and intense. The bouquet gently wafts from the glass in a complex blend of apple, pear, lilacs, a lovely foundation of slate minerality, lime blossoms and lavender. On the palate the wine is bright, fullish, elegant and nicely filigreed, with a pretty core of fruit, excellent mineral undertow, zesty acids and fine focus and balance on the long, complex and bouncy finish. *Reviewed by John Gilman, August 2024*

Dr. Loosen Ürziger Würzgarten Riesling Spätlese 2022

A very spicy Mosel Spätlese with aromas ranging from dried strawberry to Mediterranean herbs that are married to a stunning combination of juicy fruit and racy energy. An impressively structured wine, but this is almost all below the waterline of perception. Long, complex spicy finish. *September 2023*

The wine's bouquet is simply gorgeous, offering up scents of strawberries, fresh lime, white cherries, a beautiful foundation of minerality, iris blossoms, white lilies and apple blossoms. On the palate the wine is pure, vibrant and fullish, with lovely intensity of flavor, zesty acids, fine mineral drive and grip, impeccable balance and a long, complex and dancing finish. I often think that Spätlese is the perfect Prädikat level to express the Würzgarten's inimitable terroir to perfection. *Reviewed by John Gilman. August 2024*

Zesty and crunchy, with pure green apple, lemon-lime and tangerine flavors, supported by vibrant acidity. The focused finish shows accents of mint and basil. An interesting sweet, but balanced wine, delivering plenty of snap on the finish. *May 2024*

[92] *Mosel Fine Wines*

The first nose immediately catches one's attention with very spicy notes of ginger, fresh herbs, chamomile, white peach, fresh almond, hawthorn, candied lemon, and violet. The wine shows great finesse on the palate, with a hint of sweetness and creaminess. The finish is elegant and delicate, with a nice freshness thanks to the return of spices and zest. This Spätlese is very elegant and creamy. *December 2023*

There's a spicy edge to this Spätlese, with ground ginger, lanolin and citrus zest flavors invigorating a ripe base of apricot and juicy melon. Flint and wet stone notes bring a cooling mineral feel, with good acidity powering the tingling finish. *June 2024*

Vines in the red-tinged soil of this amphitheater produce some of the Mosel's most enticing wines — this one taking a softer approach to an explosive site. Understated, clean and approachable, this Spätlese is laden with flavors of salted citrus zest. *Reviewed by Jonathan Eichholz, March 2024*

Chicago Wine Press

This is a wine of pedigree with a crystalline pure color and heavenly scented floral aromas. The wine unveils juicy, mouth-filling fruits with macerated tangerines, freshly baked peach cobbler, honeyed Meyer lemons and crushed pineapple laced with a layer of complex spices. It is finely detailed with just enough acidity and a hint of extraordinary purity and leads to an endless finish. It is destined to live for a few decades or longer. Dr. Loosen Wehlener Sonnenuhr Riesling Spätlese 2022

[95] *Wine & Spirits* — Best Buy —

This concentrated Spätlese hits the confluence of citrus pulp, tarragon and the kind of vibrant acidity that will set your tongue in motion. This is a wine for the cellar, or, if you are impatient, there's plenty here to reward your opening the bottle now. *Reviewed by Jonathan Eichholz, March 2024*

Brimming with stone fruits with delicate floral honey and caramelized pear aromas. Ripe and generous, but with a lively acidity that keeps this moving briskly over the palate. Long finish in which creamy and crisp elements are beautifully balanced. *September 2023*

The bouquet is pure, precise and vivid, wafting from the glass in a mix of pear, white cherries, vanilla bean, a touch of kiwi, a beautifully complex base of blue slate and a lovely floral top note of both apple and citrus blossoms. On the palate the wine is bright, fullish and seamlessly balanced, with a beautiful core of fruit, fine slate undertow, zesty acids and a long, nascently complex and very refined finish. *Reviewed by John Gilman. [91+] *Mosel Fine Wines*

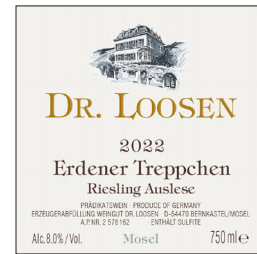
Initially slightly reduced, the nose takes a few minutes to open up, presenting notes of lime, freshly cut herbs, green apple, black pepper, flint, nutmeg, and candied orange. The wine shows a direct acid column and also a slightly tannic and tart edge, with plenty of citrusy fruits and spices. The finish is focused and salivating, with tartness also needing to integrate. *December 2023 – Issue #68*

[91] *Wine Enthusiast*

Elegant and full of ripe apple, pear and peach flavors in an attractive, easy-going way. It is balanced, with enough complexity to keep it interesting, yet not too intellectual. *May 2024*

[90] *Wine Spectator*

Warm and inviting, with a good balance between juicy ripeness and savory verve. Offers mouthwatering pink grapefruit acidity, while sun tea and orange marmalade notes add warmth. A well-integrated mineral spice keeps the energy high. *June 2024*

The wine's bouquet is flat out beautiful, wafting from the glass in a mix of pear, fresh pineapple, a touch of mango, honeycomb, slate minerality, iris blossoms, white lilies and citrus zest. On the palate the wine is fullish, pure, vibrant and complex, with a lovely core, good acids and fine focus and grip on the long, complex and ethereal finish. I love the understated, non-botrytis personality of this Auslese, which will age beautifully well. *Reviewed by John Gilman. August 2024*

From vines in iron-rich soils at the warm and sunbaked Erdener Treppchen, this fruit ripened to a high level. Loosen's 2022 Auslese will take you straight to the peach orchard. With a wonderful spectrum from crunchy and underripe peaches to spiced compote, it's a wine of depth and pleasure. *Reviewed by Jonathan Eichholz, March 2024*

[92+] *Mosel Fine Wines*

It offers a fresh, spicy, and smoky nose of conference pear, minty herbs, anise, acacia, lime, cassis leaf, bay leaf, and flint. The wine is juicy, with a certain smoothness and finesse on the palate. It leaves a fresh yet sweet impression in the finish. This light Auslese will need a few years to integrate its sugar, but clearly has potential if it gains in finesse and intensity. *December 2023 – Issue #68*

[92] *Wine Enthusiast*

A rich, compact style, offering lemon and brioche aromas, and flavors, with a hint of saffron-glazed pear. Backed by a lively structure, this shows fine balance and a lingering aftertaste of white pepper and sea salt. *May 2024*

Hauntingly smoky nose with delicate spicy notes and stacks of citrus zest freshness. Then comes a wave of mangosteen, star fruit and passion fruit on the succulent yet vivid palate. The major structure behind all this becomes more and more obvious, even assertive, as the wine charges across the palate. Stunning length. *September 2023*

[94] *Mosel Fine Wines*

The nose is immediately captivating, with notes of spices, vineyard peach, honeyed pear, mint, pineapple, cinnamon, acacia, coconut, quince, and orange peel. The wine has a superb balance on the palate, between great ripeness and fresh fruits and acidity, which is almost sharp and certainly lively. The finish is long and precise, and even slightly sharp. This Auslese is impressive for its interplay between ripeness and freshness

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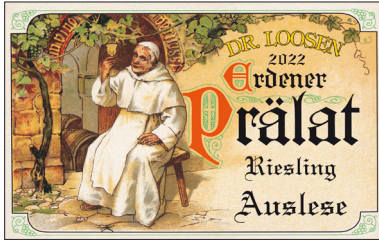
