Robert Weil Kiedrich Gräfenberg Riesling Trockenbeerenauslese 2022



[99] *James Suckling*

A giant TBA that shows why the nobly sweet Riesling wines of this category are a legend. Tasting this is like gazing into a deep abyss with a vast depth of dried exotic fruits, complex exotic spices and floral honey. Huge structure and an acidity that's vibrant enough to wake the dead. Very limited production. Still needs many years of bottle age to reach its youthful best.

[98] *Wine Enthusiast* — Cellar Selection—

The thick and syrupy texture makes you want to pour this over your crêpes — and you probably wouldn't regret it. However, this is pure excellence in the glass, with an earth and mineral component that is contributing to the already complex palate. Honey, apricot, lime and spice notes converge, all supported by brilliant acidity. Starts out creamy, yet its freshness makes it easy to enjoy. A perfect way to end a meal. *May 2024*

[98] *Vinous*

It has the merest touch of dark fir honey, only a notion of darker fruit. The palate is lovely and barely shows botrytis at this exuberant stage of its life. The sweetness is immense and speaks of candied peach, crystallized Mirabelle and intense citrus, think candied tangerine and orange peel. It's incisive, highly aromatic, lasting and oh-so pure. Robert Weil Kiedrich Gräfenberg Riesling Beerenauslese 2022

A magnificent Rheingau BA with an enormous depth of dried apricot and dried mango character. Very compact and structured, this really needs some years of further aging to reach its youthful best form. Excellent balance, also due to the very vibrant acidity that underlies the tremendous richness. *September 2023—Reviewed by Stuart Pigott*

[97] *Vinous*

The nose is vivid with slightly dried white currant and pale sultana. The palate is super fresh but also super concentrated. Candied peach, supple, defined and pure, the 2022 becomes as intense as a crystallized peach. Peach flesh, skin compote and candied fruit are all here. The sweetness is immense, but so is the acidity which delineates and illuminates all. The mouthfeel is viscous. This is precious, intense and lasting. *December 22, 2023-Reviewed by Anne Krebiehl*

[95] *Wine Enthusiast* — Cellar Selection—

Plenty of honeyed notes here, dripping over with overripe apricot, candied orange peel and guava. Acidity picks up midpalate, accenting the apricot and citrus flavors in this intense dessert wine. It's focused with balance coming from its powerful acidity. Fine-tuned on the long, complex finish. *May 2024*

Robert Weil Kiedrich Gräfenberg Riesling GG 2022



[97] *JamesSuckling* — Top 100 Wines of Germany 2023 (#92)—

Deep and ripe nose with fine apricot, mango and papaya aromas. Stunning concentration, the ripeness and creaminess married to a wonderful mineral freshness that keeps this compact wine moving steadily over the palate. Giant, yet very precise finish. Great aging potential.

[96] *Vinous*

It has a notion of tangerine alongside yellow plum, followed by yellow plum skin and citrus peel. The palate is juicy, almost bouncy, with Reine Claude's vividness, pervaded by zesty, ripe lemon resting on a gentle layer of yeast. It's concentrated, almost allowing glimpses of more distant, tropical fruit, yet all within that frame of citric freshness. It shows tautness, linearity, direction and energy with Weil's drive, yet it is always cool and dynamic. We only see a fraction of this power at this point, but it is undoubtedly there. Subtle citrus perfume denotes elegance, but the muscular elegance gets you. Wow.

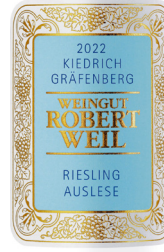
[93] *Mosel Fine Wines*

Offers a beautifully flowery and superbly complex and finely aromatic nose of jasmine, vineyard peach, almond cream, Conference pear, bergamot, violet, and blueberry. The wine is refined and delicately juicy and creamy on the layered and fresh palate. Plenty of fine spices and zest bring a superbly lively side to the wine. The finish is superbly well delineated, refined, and precise. This is a splendid dry Riesling full of complexity, refinement, and airiness. *September 2023-Issue No. 67*

Powerful acidity takes over the citrus and orchard-fruit flavors. A bit hard to understand now, but flavors of kumquat and quince emerge with air, while eucalyptus, mineral and spice details add to the charm. *May 2024*

A mighty Riesling Auslese, but with the purity and precision that marks out the greatest wines of this category in the 2022 vintage. Great exotic fruit coulis character with stacks of passion fruit, but also King Alphonso mango. The super-long finish is as compact as it is vibrant. So much mineral freshness.

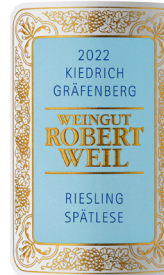
The nose opens with Mirabelle compote and a golden note of ripe apricot skins. The palate is beautifully sweet and concentrated, channeling golden, almost candied Mirabelle and apricot. The acidity is concentrated, bringing this to a beautiful thrill, making this sharp but delicious. The 2022 is exciting, lip-smacking, utterly pure and heightened in style, without any taint of botrytis.

Concentrated, with orchard-blossom honey and candied orange notes all balanced by a vibrant structure. It evolves midpalate, offering roasted pineapple, cardamom and ripe apricot. The impression is one of a fresh, ripe juiciness with a lingering finish. *May 2024*

I love the way the tropical fruit extravagance of this wine is married to a dangerously refreshing acidity that lifts this remarkable Spätlese up into the upper stratosphere. [95] *Vinous*

The vivid aroma of these stone fruits is delineated on the palate, boosted by residual sweetness like sorbet made from the fruit, melting on the palate and releasing its aroma moment by moment, reaching a peak of creamy peach ice cream, always tempered by vivid freshness and a tangy citrus edge. Just so elegant, so zesty, so beautiful, so balanced. Squeaky clean, elegant, striking and delicious.

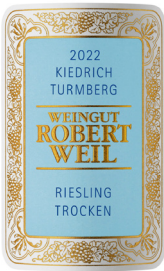

Attractive flavors of jellied citrus, guava, ripe apricot and quince mark this exuberant, open-knit version. It shows great energy and cut, which keep it well defined through the lingering aftertaste. *May 2024*

Robert Weil Kiedrich Turmberg Riesling Trocken 2022

Stunning racy brilliance and wet stone minerality are married to complex aromas of white peach, hibiscus and a hint of mangosteen. So fine and precise, so light-footed and subtle for the impressive concentration. Mountain stream clarity at the super-long finish.

The nose is vivid with flickers of bergamot surrounding Reine Claude plums. The palate is immediately framed in citrus freshness. A zesty, aromatic allure combines greenish citrus with bright lemon. The palate has substance, but the citric notion is insistent, aromatic and mouthwatering. There is almost a flicker of mint in the background. The palate is concentrated, slender, bright, taut, and straight-laced. There's a lovely citrus finish. The 2022 is sophisticated, cool and serene. *December 22, 2023—Reviewed by Anne Krebiehl*

This shows aromas of grapefruit, peach blossom and mineral to the elegant profile and silky texture. This is harmonious and classic, with a lingering aftertaste of citrus and mineral salt. *May 2024*

The nose is aromatic, suggesting Reine Claude plum, white peach and green pear skin. Clarity also defines the palate where riper stone fruit shines, framed by grapefruit skin. This has serenity, tautness and substance, despite slenderness. Mouth-watering zestiness appears on the finish.

A zesty, tangy style, with lemon and lanolin flavors fused to a linear frame. It is nicely built with a balanced and moderately long, salty aftertaste salt. *May 2024*

Robert Weil Riesling Spätlese 2022

A very typical Rheingau Riesling Spätlese with a wonderful freshness and vitality that, together with the racy acidity, beautifully counterbalances the touch of grape sweetness. Very grapey with as much wild berry fruit as white peach character. Long, zesty and creamy finish.

Robert Weil Kiedrich Gräfenberg Riesling Auslese Goldkapsel 2022

Dense mango chutney, curry leaf and cep mushroom aromas are married to a slew of floral honey. Great density and a fabulous interplay of lushness, northern freshness and spicy complexity that extends right through the very imposing finish.

[96] *Vinous*

A note of glossy, liquid blossom honey characterizes the nose where botrytis is not apparent. With more air and temperature, the golden apricot fruit comes through, rich, aromatic, pure and lifted. The palate is viscous and intensely sweet, combining Mirabelle, peach and apricot in a compote of intensity and fleshiness but showing utter purity and concentration. This is so intense, lovely and luscious, always with that citrus edge to make your mouth water. A high-wire act. *December 22, 2023—Reviewed by Anne Krebiehl*
