





This white-hay-colored wine offers an engaging nose made of floral elements, ripe orchard fruits, fine spices, and smoke. It is nicely playful on the palate and leaves a beautifully multi-layered feel of juicy fruits, minerals, and fine spices in the long and nicely balanced finish. The aftertaste is full of fresh flavors and fine spices. This is a beautiful expression of dry Riesling which combines direct drinking pleasure with complexity. December 2024-Issue No. 74

This white-hay-colored wine offers a beautifully backward nose made of pear, spices, mirabelle, citrusy elements, brown sugar, and smoke. It is playful and subtly creamy on the palate, where the fruity side is wrapped in succulent acidity. The finish proves long, engaging, and yet also multi-faceted. 
Dr. Loosen Wehlener Sonnenuhr Riesling GG 2023


Dr. Loosen Bernkasteler Lay Riesling GG 2023

This white-hay-colored wine offers a refreshing nose made of grapefruit zest, elderflower, apricot blossom, herbs, spices, and smoke. 

This hay-colored wine offers a quite delicate and finely chiseled nose made of bitter grapefruit, mirabelle, fine spices, and herbs. It is subtly precise and quite focused on the fully dry tasting palate and leaves a focused feel of fruit wrapped in fine herbal elements in the long finish. Dr. Loosen Graacher Domprobst Riesling GG 2023

[91] Mosel Fine Wines

This hay-colored wine proves still rather backward at first and takes a while to reveal its subtle nose made of pear, brown sugar, elderflower, ginger, and smoke. It proves nicely tart and precise on the palate and leaves a still rather firm and structured feel in the finish. It is only in the aftertaste that some of the great flavors of fruits, minerals, and fine spices come through. *December 2024-Issue No. 74*




Dr. Loosen Kinheimer Rosenberg Riesling GG 2023


Dr. Loosen Blue Slate Dry Riesling Kabinett 2023



This green-hay-colored wine offers a superbly complex and creamy nose made of dark spices, almond paste, passion fruit, bergamot, brown sugar, and smoke. The wine is firmly zesty on the palate and the stunningly pure flavors of almond cream and fine spices only emerge in the beautifully airy finish at this stage. This is a beautiful Auslese in the making, but one which will best be enjoyed earlier rather than later, to avoid the risk of acidity taking over. December 2024-Issue No. 74
