Winemaking Notes

Dark bramble fruit and old fashioned plum aromas are framed by cedar and a subtle cigar tobacco note.

The palate is rich and rounded, with chocolatey depth and firm framing tannins. Full bodied and generous, yet structured. A long finish of lingering bramble fruits, chocolate and tobacco leaf.
