Wine has been flowing in the Clare Valley since 1851 and is an integral part of the culture. A small area, accounting for less than 1.5% of Australia's total wine production, it is one of Australia's most prestigious premium wine regions, most famous for its Riesling and Shiraz. With its beautiful rolling hills, ideal winter rainfall, and Mediterranean climate, the Clare Valley carries a unique history and winemaking heritage.

The tiny village of Watervale (population of 246), nestled at the southern end of the Valley, is renowned for the quality of its Riesling. Our Watervale Riesling is picked from a special part of the Florita vineyard in Watervale. This famous Riesling vineyard usually achieves full ripeness with high natural acid levels.

Winemaking Notes

The 2024 Watervale Riesling opens with explosive florals, star fruit and yellow peach aromas.

The aromas carry through to the palate, where a firm but relaxed lime citrus core is framed with peach and rockmelon, delivering an even flow throughout.
